Talk by Peter and Eileen Crichton

This evening's talk was to have been given by Kate Ward but she had to cancel. Fortunately, we have been able to obtain Peter and Eileen Crichton, but, albeit, giving an illustrated talk on a totally different subject.

Peter and Eileen gave us a talk in November 2009 titled “Hidden Gems”. Both lived in Saudia Arabia for over 10 years and it was there that their long distance travelling adventures began. These have included circling the world twice in their Landrover “Rabia”, a circumnavigation of Arabia and a separate circumnavigation of Africa starting and finishing in England.

Their presentation this evening is in keeping with the recent snowy weather and is based on digital images recorded last year during a 5 week adventure through Scandinavia to reach the most northerly point in Europe accessible by vehicle. If you saw “71 Degrees North” recently shown on TV, this was the final destination of that series. Continuing south from there, the journey attempts to follow the most westerly possible route going south, down Norway's ocean coastline, including many of the off-shore islands north of the Arctic Circle.
